

Rules for participants and guests during the II Eurasia Regional Jamboree

1. Scouts safety rules

1.1 Instructing participants

Before the jamboree, each participant should be instructed by the delegate Leader about the behavior and safety rules (finding in the woods, fire treatment, tools using, bathing, etc.), also about the health and sanitation rules. Additional special instructions participants will receive before the events themselves.

1.2 Participants attribute

Each of the participants will receive a scarf and a badge, these 2 symbols proving their involvement in the Jamboree. It's mandatory to wear the scarf and the badge during the Jamboree.

1.3 Jamboree guests

On the territory of the Jamboree are prohibited entries of unauthorized persons without special registration. After the registration, the guest will have to communicate the purpose of Jamboree's visit, the estimated time of the visit and the place of residence. Also, every guest will receive a card (icon) with a "Jamboree Guest 2010" logo and his or her contact data will be recorded. In case if you meet a person without a badge or guest card and which is suspect, please immediately inform the sub camp security service of the Jamboree.

In the absence of the badge or guest badge people can be detained by the security service.

1.4. Information regarding the territory limits of the Jamboree

It is forbidden to leave the territory of the Jamboree without the delegation's leader consent and without announcing the administrative center. The team leader must always know where his scouts are. If the scout does not return back, the team leader shall immediately notify the leadership of the Jamboree.

1.5 Silence time

When the silence time starts in the camp should be quiet. All the scouts should be in camp after 24:00, or have the leader's permission for other activities at this hour. Security service of the Jamboree has the right to penalize scouts that don't respect the silence time rules.

1.6 Bathing

Bathing is carried out strictly in the designed areas in the presence of a responsible person (lifeguard). Swimming in the absence of the head over 18 years is strictly forbidden.

1.7. The use of harmful substances for health

1.7.1 On the territory of the Jamboree is prohibited:

- Underage smoking among the Jamboree participants;
- Participants smoking older than 18 years old in the camp or during the Jamboree's activities;
- Drinking of alcoholic beverages (including low-alcoholic drinks);
- The use of substances with toxic or narcotic effect.

1.7.2 For smokers (persons over 18 years) will be established a special area for smoking outside the Jamboree's territory, area which will be equipped according to the rules of fire safety. Smoking is strictly forbidden on the Jamboree's territory or near the Jamboree activities.

1.7.3 The sale of alcohol and tobacco products is prohibited on the territory of the Jamboree. Participants and guests are responsible for the distribution of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, narcotic or toxic substances.

Administration of the Jamboree has the right to examine immediately in the infirmary or medical center of the Jamboree for toxic, alcohol or drugs influence . Participants refusal can be examined as a violation of the Jamboree's rules.

1.8 Security rules while working with campfire

1.8.1 Saws, axes should be stored in specially designated areas.

1.8.2 Campfire is allowed only in long pants and closed shoes. It is also necessarily to use campfire mittens.

2. Medicine

2.1 Before traveling each participant of the Jamboree must do a medical check, to obtain a certificate about his health state. Every delegated leader must have these data.

2.2 During the Jamboree, the participant must immediately inform the head of emerging health problems or injuries. If the leader is not nearby, the participant must announce any adult or directly the medical center

If the leader is not nearby, the participant must announce any adult or directly announce the medical center. The leader will lead the child to the medical center, in cases of injury threat or any illness.

2.3 Each delegation must have a first aid kit.

During the camp activities each group shall have:

- Standard first-aid kit;
- Flasks with drinking water.

2.4 Participants with special health problems should have with them the necessary medicines. The leader must know about the disease and be able to help.

2.5 Each participant must have a hat while being under the sun.

2.6 Each participant must draw a full medical insurance.

3. Sanitary and epidemiological safety

3.1 It is allowed only in specially designated and marked places:

- a) collection of drinking water;
- b) washing and brushing teeth;
- c) swimming;
- d) toilet using;
- e) washing.

3.2 Nutrition

- 3.2.1 Eating is allowed only after washing or special treatment with the hand disinfectants.
- 3.2.2 Cleaning is carried out in a dedicated place after each meal in 4 waters (requirement SanPiN).
- 3.2.3 Storage of products is carried out in a dedicated place in the appropriate boxes.
- 3.2.4 It is forbidden:
- a) using of unboiled water for drinking;
 - b) eating unwashed vegetables and fruits;
 - c) storage and handling of perishable products.
- 3.2.5 If you suspect an occurrence of some infectious diseases or any gastro-intestinal disorders among the participants, the team leader must immediately inform about this the chief doctor of the Jamboree.

4. Environmental safety

Camp place will broke down according to the rules of fire and environmental safety.

4.1 Equipment of campfire sites

Campfires breeding are allowed only agreed with the fire and environmental safety in the field.

4.2. The use of dry garbage

Paper and wood waste must be incinerated. Plastic garbage, glass, rubber will be put in dense tied plastic bags and brought in designated areas. Iron banks burnt at fire, will be flattened and put in trash bags. Garbage bags are regularly exported by special transport.

4.3 Harvesting of firewood and poles for arranging parking place of the camp

It is strictly forbidden to fell any trees and bushes or chop the green branches. It is allowed to collect fallen trees and fallen trees in advance.

If you are involved in the construction of a living on a growing tree, the construction must be sealed only with ropes. It is strictly forbidden to hammer nails into living trees or other means to cause them harm.

4.4. Cleaning of the camp place at the end of the Jamboree

At the end of the Jamboree, the territory should have the same form as before. All the buildings completely will be disassembled, poles and boards are brought in the specified location. Campfire place is cleaned, filled with water.

5. Responsibility

For violation of the rules of this instruction participants and guests may pay fines. In case of systematic violation (2 times or more) guests are forbidden to find themselves on the Jamboree's territory, participants, in turn, will be removed to a specific area (outside the territory of the Jamboree). In this case, the responsibility for the lives and health of the participants are in the responsibility of the delegation leaders. The camp participation fee is not refundable. Participants may be invited to individual programs only in case of respecting the rules mentioned above and safety rules.

6. Pedagogical requirements

6.1 Each Jamboree participant is a member of the Scout Movement, and shares its essential requirements.

6.2 Every leader, who participates at the Jamboree, has no right to ignore violations of the Scout promise and the spirit of Scouting, particularly the safety rules.
