Inter-Event programme

After the Youth Forum, the **participants who will attend the Conference** will go to Suncheon for an inter-event programme. In Suncheon, the participants will stay in a Youth Hostel and go to Jeju Island by ship after the inter-event. The inter-event programme is only organised for those young adults who will participate in both the Youth Forum and Conference and who have been registered in advance for both events.

The Korean Scout Association has requested that participants on the Inter-Event programme should bring one traditional item per country. The distribution of the items will take place upon their arrival in Suncheon and the traditional items will be exhibited during the inter-event. It would be appreciated to donate those items to Suncheon City for holding the inter-event.

Reminder: Participants who will join the inter-event programme will have transport provided to get to Jeju Island and the Conference venue, **but have to buy their own ticket to fly from Jeju Island back to Seoul or any another destination** after the Conference (except for people supported by operation Saekdong).

You will need to provide your full name as it is in your passport, your passport number and your date of birth. If you do not have one you will NOT be permitted to travel to Korea by the airline.
