Greetings from Manila!

We are pleased to inform you that the World Scout Bureau/Asia-Pacific Region in collaboration with National Association of Cambodia Scouts is organizing the Youth Programme and Training Commissioner's Forum. This forum is organized based on Vision 2013 and to achieve one of the objectives under Youth Involvement priority area. This forum is also being organized in the light of Conference Resolution 10/05 (Educational Methods Structures).

The aim of this forum is to jointly gather National Youth Programme Commissioners as well as National Training Commissioners from the Asia- Pacific Region to discuss and share policies, promising practices and matters that is of interest to these leaders and which has an impact on achieving the Mission of Scouting.

Details of the Forum are as follows:

Date: 7-10 July 2009

Venue: Siam Reap, Cambodia. The town is 7 km from the Siem Reap-Angkor International Airport . Siem Reap is accessible by direct flights from Phnom Penh (capital of Cambodia), Singapore, Bangkok, Kuala Lumpur, Hong Kong, Seoul-Incheon, and Taipei, and by land from Phnom Penh and the Thai border. It's also accessible by boat and bus from Phnom Penh.

Fee: US\$150.00, which will include local transportation, food, accommodation of five nights, forum documents, forum souvenirs, educational tour, etc.

Eligibility:

- National Youth Programme Commissioners and National Training Commissioners;
- National Adult Resources Commissioners, who is also responsible for Adult Leader Training;
- Also welcomed are full time executives responsible for Youth Programme, Leader Training and Adult Resources.

Travel Arrangement: Participants should plan to arrive on 6 July 2009 and may leave 11 July 2009.

We urge all National Scout Organization's to send their respective Youth Programme and Training Commissioners to this unique event.
