**AGREEMENT TO USE THE WORLD SCOUT ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMME**  
(PACK 2 for commercial use)

The parties to the present agreement have agreed on the following:

**Introduction What is the World Scout Environment Programme?**

The World Scout Environment Programme offers tools, resources and initiatives to help Scouts all around the world work together for the good of the local and global environment.

The World Scout Environment Programme is a free, very straightforward, flexible and easy to implement programme and does not compete with NSAs' existing programme. It complements it and the World Scout Environment Badge and activities can fit within the global Youth Programme framework.

The NSAs are offered two possibilities when adopting the World Scout Environment Programme.

I. PACK 1: Basic Package

The Basic Package is a free educational (non-commercial) package with all the material needed to start the World Scout Environment Programme in the NSA.

II. PACK 2: Commercial Use

This package contains all of the elements of PACK 1 with the additional possibility for the NSA to create its own financial resources to sponsor its national programme.

This **PACK 2** agreement between the NSA and WSB contains the terms and conditions of the use World Scout Environment Programme, which contains the use of the Guidelines, Logo and Badge to develop the programme at a National level, as well as a commercial license to produce articles bearing the World Scout Environment Programme Logo.

**Article 1 Object of the agreement**

*§ 1 Contents* The WSB authorises the NSA to use the World Scout Environment Programme, which contains the use of the material listed in § 2. PACK 2 also includes a commercial license to produce merchandising articles, which conditions are described in Article 5.

**Article 2 Commitment to Programme and respect of content and objectives**

The NSA must also agree to:

- Commit itself to respect the content and objectives of the World Scout

Environment Programme, as well the criteria for obtaining the World Scout Environment Badge.

- Integrate the World Scout Environment Programme into its own programme for its various age sections as appropriate.
- Commit itself to regularly evaluate the activities against the World Scout Environment Programme in order to ensure that the programme is implemented properly.

### **Article 3 Translation**

*§ 1 Possibility to translate* If the contents of the PACK 2 are not available in the language used by the NSA's members, the NSA has the possibility to translate the material.

*§ 2 Cost of translation* The translation's cost will be borne by the NSA.

*§ 3 Conditions to translation* The NSA may proceed to do the translation under the following conditions:

- WSB is informed of the translation.
- The translation work must be done with care, without making additions or deletions contrary to good translation practice. The WSB has the right to suggest corrections to the translation.
- NSA agrees to provide WSB with the translation so that it may benefit others. This implies transfer of copyright of the translation to the WSB for non-commercial and commercial use. The NSA will retain the right to reproduce the translated material for non-commercial use and commercial use (within the conditions described in this agreement).

### **Article 4 Conditions of use of PACK 2**

*§ 1 Compliance to conditions* This license is granted on the following additional conditions and failure to comply with them shall lead to automatic revocation.

*§ 2 Extent of the authorisation* The NSA is granted a non-exclusive, non-transferable authorisation to use PACK 2 for educational purposes and commercial use (see Article 5) within the framework defined in the Guidelines for the Programme.

*§ 3 Good quality* The NSA agrees to ensure the good quality of the reproduction of the material.

*§ 4 Compliance with Visual Guidelines* The NSA must comply with the visual/design guidelines contained in World Scout Environment Programme Identity Guide in order to have a consistent use of the Logo and Badge.

### **Article 5 Commercial License of the World Scout Environment Programme Logo**

*§ 1 Produce merchandising* PACK 2 also includes a license to use the World Scout Environment Programme Logo to produce merchandising articles to promote the World Scout Environment Programme and generate some income to support the Programme.

*§ 2 Royalties* The commercial license is granted against payment to the WSB of royalties of 10% on production cost of each merchandising article produced.

*§ 2 Additional conditions* The commercial license is granted with the following additional conditions:

- The NSA must inform WSB of products which it plans to produce. These products should ideally be environmentally friendly.
- The NSA must respect the merchandising catalogue which they will be provided with.

### **Article 6 Applicable Law**

This agreement is subject to Swiss Law.

### **Article 7 Forum**

The competent forum shall be in Geneva, Switzerland.
