2. 39th World Scout Conference, Brazil, 2011 – Call for invitations to host World Scout Events: 2014, 2017 and 2019.

The World Scout Committee requests invitations to host the following events:

- 40th World Scout Conference and 12th World Scout Youth Forum, 2014
- 15th World Scout Moot, 2017
- 24th World Scout Jamboree, 2019

World Scout Events need considerable time to organise and they require support from many other organisations and governmental authorities. In each case, the host country must provide a satisfactory venue and the necessary organisational infrastructure, including services and staff. Moreover, the organisation of such

events requires considerable financial support from within the host country. National Scout Organizations that are interested in hosting these events are invited to contact the World Scout Bureau before they formalise their invitation in order to be fully informed about the official guidelines and requirements for the hosting of these different world events.
