



**7<sup>th</sup> APR Scout Leaders Summit**  
**The Atria Hotel, Bangalore, Karnataka, India**  
**24-27 June 2010**

**General Information**

- Summit Date** The Summit will be held from 24-27 June 2010. Participants are expected to arrive on 23 June and may leave on 28 June 2010.
- Venue** The venue for the Summit is the Atria Hotel, Bangalore, Karnataka, India. The hotel is strategically located in palace road in the heart of the city. It is easily accessible to MG Road - the corporate hub of Bangalore which is just 5 km away. It is also accessible from the airport in 45 minutes and less than 10 minutes from the city railway station. For more information, you may visit the website at <http://www.atriahotel.com>.
- Registration Fee** US\$250.00 per person in twin sharing rooms. Fee will cover inland transportation, all meals (from lunch on 23 June to breakfast on 28 June) and accommodation for 5 nights on twin sharing basis, educational tour, summit documents and souvenirs.
- If any participant wishes to stay in a single room, an additional amount of US\$30.00 per person per day to the above package price will be required.
- For additional days on or before the meeting, the rate is US\$50.00 per person per day for twin sharing accommodation including breakfast and US\$30.00 per day for single occupancy with breakfast.
- Accompanying person's fee** US\$200.00 per person. The fee will include airport transfers, accommodation in twin-sharing rooms for 5 nights (23-27 June), educational tour with Summit participants, and all meals (from 23 June dinner up to breakfast on 28 June).
- Accompanying person's programme** Local program will be offered. There are additional packages to choose from with specific costs. Details will follow shortly.
- Sub- committee meetings registration fee** For the sub- committee meetings, the package fee for sub-committee members is US\$100.00. This will cover 2 nights (21-22 June) accommodation on twin sharing basis. The fee package includes airport transfers, all meals (from lunch on 21 June until breakfast on 23 June).
- If any participant wishes to stay in a single room, an additional amount of US\$30.00 per person per day to the above package price will be required.
- For additional days on or before the meeting, the rate is US\$50.00 per person per day for twin sharing accommodation including breakfast and US\$30.00 per day for single occupancy with breakfast.

<b>Visa</b>	Please check with your travel agent or the nearest Indian Embassy or Consul for the visa requirements. If you need invitation letter, write to The Bharat Scouts & Guides well ahead of time to have ample time in securing your visas. In your request for visa letter, please provide your complete passport details (name, passport no., date of birth, date and place of issuance, date of expiry) so as to facilitate visa request letters. In case of Bangladesh, Pakistan, Sri Lanka kindly check on other information needed.
<b>APR Scout Foundation Fundraising Dinner</b>	The host has planned an APR Scout Foundation Fundraising Dinner on 25 June. As the dinner will be sponsored locally, the dinner tickets will be US\$50.00 per person and the hosts are looking forward that all participants will be attending. Target attendance is 200 persons, 100 from the Summit and 100 locals from Bangalore.
<b>Weather</b>	Due to its elevation, Bangalore is blessed with relatively pleasant climate. The city of Bangalore counts amongst the few cities in India that experience an agreeable weather throughout the year. Bangalore's weather in June varies between 20°C - 29°C.
<b>Airport Reception</b>	The Bharat Scouts & Guides Leaders in scout uniform will be waiting at the airport lobby after you clear the customs. Delegates are requested to wear a scarf or any other visible scout insignia for easy identification.
<b>Food</b>	Vegetarian, non-vegetarian and halal food will be served separately during the summit. If you have any special requirements, please inform the host in advance.
<b>What to bring</b>	Scout uniform, personal clothing, light pullover, slippers, personal toiletries, medicine, etc.
<b>Flags</b>	Participating NSOs are requested to bring one (1) NSO flag with the size of about 120 cm x 180 cm.
<b>Currency</b>	Indian rupee is the local currency. Current exchange rate US\$1 = 46.1889 Indian rupee (as of 24 Feb 2010).  US\$ is widely used, so carry US\$ cash or TC, VISA Cards, Master Cards are accepted in most hotels and restaurants.
