## 1. Correction: Circular N° 16/2010 on Scout and Guide National Organizations (SAGNOs)

Circular No. 16/2010 was sent to all National Scout Organizations in May 2010. Attached to that circular was a definition of "Scout and Guide National Organizations" (commonly known as "SAGNOs") approved by the World Scout Committee for use in WOSM.

Our sister organization the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) has drawn to our attention that the text contained in a footnote on page 1 of that document, describing WAGGGS' policy on membership of boys and men in WAGGGS, was incorrect. The document has therefore been amended with the following new footnote which states in more accurate detail WAGGGS' policy on the subject:

"While not directly relevant to the purpose of this paper, WAGGGS has recently announced a change in its policy concerning membership of boys and men. The membership of SAGNO Organizations in WAGGGS is outlined in WAGGGS' Constitution, Article 9 c) which indicates that only girls and women in a SAGNO are considered to be the WAGGGS members of that Member Organization. However, all WAGGGS' Member Organizations which had been accepted into membership of WAGGGS prior to January 2010 with boys within their membership will continue to hold membership of WAGGGS and may continue to count boys as members

if they wish to do so. This includes any SAGNO Member Organization whose male membership had been accepted as WAGGGS' members prior to January 2010. Any Associate Member Organization meeting the preceding condition will be allowed to obtain Full Membership. Member Organizations may have adult males as members."

In accordance with Article XII of the Constitution, the following six members of the World Scout Committee will retire from office at the 39th World Scout Conference:

Subsequent to the amendments made to Article XII,3 of the Constitution at the last World Scout Conference, elections will be held at the World Conference in Brazil to fill the resulting vacancies for the period 2011-2014. Consequently, the delegates will elect, from the list of candidates, six members for a period of three years.

**5. 11th World Scout Youth Forum, Brazil, 3-6 January, 2011 Call for nominations for Youth Advisors**

In accordance with the World Scout Youth Forum Guidelines, the following five Youth Advisors of the World Scout Committee, elected at the 10 th World Scout Youth Forum in Korea 2008, will retire from office at the 11th World Scout Youth Forum:

  - Miss Fernanda Santos Soares (Brazil)
- Mr. Kevin Li (Canada) was also elected as a Youth Advisor but stood down due to changes in his personal circumstances.

Elections will be held at the World Scout Youth Forum in Brazil to fill the resulting vacancies for the period 2011-2014. Consequently, the delegates will elect, from the list of candidates, six Youth Advisors for a period of three years (2011-2014). A Youth Advisor is not eligible for re-election.

If your Organization wishes to make a nomination, the enclosed nomination form, duly filled in, must reach the World Scout Bureau **no later than Friday 12 November 2010**. The consent of the nominee must be obtained before his or her name is submitted.
