Subject: 16th Rover Moot 2004

We are pleased to inform you that the Bangladesh Scouts is organising the 16th Rover Moot 2004 at Bahadurpur Rover Scout Training Centre, Gazipur, Bangladesh from 12~19 January, 2004.

Details of the Moot are as follows:

Date: 12~19 January 2004. Participants are requested to arrive on 11 January 2004 and my plan to leave Bangladesh on 20 January 2004.

Participants will be received at the Zia International Airport, Dhaka by the Moot Reception Committee. If any overseas unit desires to go to sight seeing tour, they have to have visa extended after 20 January 2004. The expenses of sight seeing tour is not included in the Moot fee. Bangladesh Scouts, Rover Region will provide guides during the tour.

Venue: Bahadurpur Rover Scout Training Centre, Gazipur District, Bangladesh. 42 Kilometers north of Dhaka city and half an hour's journey by road from Zia International Airport, Dhaka.

Theme: Rovering for Human Resource Development

Fee: The Moot fee for each overseas participant is US\$100.00 only and payable in cash upon arrival. The fee covers inland transportation from Zia International Airport, Dhaka to Bahadurpur and back, souvenir items, food and accommodation in tents from 11 to 20 January 2004.

Programme Highlights: Wide range of activities will be offered including Pioneering, Community Development Activities, Exhibition, Wall magazine, Adventure, Youth Forum, Sports and Games, Cultural Shows, International Evening Programme etc.

Home Hospitality: Home hospitality may be arranged for overseas participants for one or two days before or after the Moot.

Eligibility Rover Scouts (male or female) who are 16-25 years of age and are registered members of their NSOs with leaders (warranted Scouter, male or female) are eligible to attend.
