Summary

Following results of the First Working Session on Training Systems, held in June in Budapest, small group of experts from France, Slovenia, UK and European Scout Region met over weekend 10 - 12 November in Geneva to continue developing specific approach in designing or renewing a training system. The group went deeper into the process and discussed many elements that constitute it. The group will continue work on designing a tool. For this reason, another larger Working Session is foreseen from 26 to 28 January.

Participants were experts, leaders and professionals active at national and European level who have recently been involved in reviewing and implementing new approaches to adult leader training, including development of new training systems.

Aim of the event

The working session was a 'think tank', based on recent experiences of the participants.

Programme

Mains questions & tasks during this event

Further work on defining possible process of development or renewing a training system led to structuring the process into three phases:

- Decision about chaining/building the training system (the pre processes)
- Framework for training system
- Design and operating the system

- The group will work on deeper understanding of the process and its presentation
- The group will also build the skeleton for the Toolkit
- Next Working Sessions to complete the process and discuss about finalizing the tool will be held from 26 to 28 January 2007
