

FIRST JAMBOREE OF EURASIA REGION

1. **Location:** Armenia, Byurakan

Official languages of Armenia: Armenian. Russian and English widely spoken.

Short Description: Armenia is a mountainous country which occupies the north-west part of the Armenian plateau (height up to 4095 m, Mount Aragatz) set off by the mountain ridge of the Lesser Caucasus. South-west _ the plain of the Mount Ararat.

Armenia is a country of old legends and Biblical stories. On his descent from Mount Ararat Noah first stepped onto this land, and, perhaps, because of his blessings, the Ararat valley is fruitful. Armenia has a wonderful nature: small mountainous waterfalls, skyscraping mountains, blue lake Sevan and a bright, shiny sun. The fruits that grow here, apricots and grapes, peaches and apples, carry the spice and aroma of the sun.

Climate: The climate is dry, with cold winters and hot summers. The average temperature in July on the foothills is +24...+26°C and on the mountains +18...+20 °C. Rainfalls varies by location and elevation, with the greatest precipitation in the mountains. The most arid region of the country is along the Araks River.

Byurakan: South-eastern slope of the Mount Aragatz. Nearest town _ Ashtarak (3 km). Distance from Yerevan _ 45 km.

2. **Terms:** August 13 – 22, 2006

3. **Age of participants:** 14 – 21 years old

4. **Theme of the Jamboree _** The role of youth in strengthening the relationship of Post-Soviet countries: cooperation through mutual cognition.

5. **Motto:** “WE ARE THE FUTURE OF EURASIA”

6. **Main aim:**

- To develop Scouting in the countries of Eurasia Region based on the traditions and culture of each country.
- To strengthen the unity of Scout Movement, development, mutual understanding and cooperation in the countries of Eurasia Region.
