APR Youth Programme Development Workshop

Dear Colleagues:

Greetings from Manila!

The Asia-Pacific Region of the World Organization of the Scout Movement in realizing the importance of Youth Programme is organizing the APR Youth Programme Development Workshop. This workshop, hosted by the Pakistan Boy Scout Association, will provide opportunity for the leaders to understand the renewed approach to programme development.

We would like to invite Scout Leaders who are involved in Youth Programme Development in their national Scout organization. The ideal participants for this workshop would be National Programme Commissioners and members of the National Programme Committee, and/or members of the Training Team.

The aim of this workshop is to gather Programme Developers, especially from countries of South Asia and share with them the technical process of developing an attractive and challenging Youth Programme for effective implementation towards continuous growth of Scouting.

At the end of the seminar, which will last five full days, participants will be able to:

1. Explain the process of developing a Youth Programme;
2. Identify and discuss the main needs and expectation of young people;
3. Explain what are the characteristics of a Scout programme able to meet these needs and expectations;
4. Help leaders identify the main elements of the Scout method adapted to the first adolescence and use them:
 - a) Symbolic Framework
 - b) Patrol system and the structures of the Scout unit
 - c) Scouting's educational proposal, Scout Law and Promise
 - d) Growth areas, educational objectives and activities
 - e) Assessing personal development: the progressive scheme
 - f) Involving young people in planning activities: the programme cycle
 - g) The role of Scout leaders

The seminar will be held from 10 – 14 December 2007 (five full days of workshop) in Islamabad, Pakistan. Participants should arrive 9 December 2007 and leave 15 December 2007.

The workshop fee is USD100.00, which covers inland transportation between the airport and the seminar venue, food, accommodation, seminar kits and educational tour. The details of the seminar venue and other information, including travel arrangements, will be advised to your association shortly.

May I request you to send at least two participants from your national Scout organization. Please return the attached reply slip not later than **31 October 2007**.

Thank you for your keen interest in attending this seminar and we will appreciate it if your national Scout organization can send representatives to this important event.
