To provide opportunity for young people to get more involved in decisions making and to interact with other Scouts from overseas, the National Scout Organization of Thailand (NSOT) organized the 2nd Thailand International Scout Youth Forum 2009 at the Phuket Scout Camp, Phuket Thailand from 10th ? 15th June 2009.



The event gathered 51 young people, including three overseas participants, one from Korea and two from Singapore.

During the opening ceremony, International Commissioner Mr Sutham Phanthusak was the guest of honor and speaker. Other guests include NSOT Executive Board members and commissioners. Mr Setthaphan Buddhani, Director of the Tourism Authority of Thailand ? Phuket Office was the guest of honor at the closing ceremony.
