Preparations for the event are going very well with all 155 National Scout Organizations having registered. And thanks to the Operation One World solidarity project, young people who would otherwise be unable to go, are being given the chance to attend the Jamboree.

Many of the partners of World Scouting will also be present, in particular UN Agencies which will showcase their programmes and participate in the Global Development Activities. This key area of the Jamboree aims to enable young people who participate to discover the principal development issues that face the world today, to develop a better understanding of those issues and how to contribute to solving them, and to acquire skills that will allow them to react to those issues in their own communities.

In addition to the 40,000 Jamboree participants, 10,000 day visitors are expected on the site each day. So it really is going to be an exciting event!
