ACCOMPANYING PERSONS' PROGRAMME & PRE AND POST CONFERENCE TOURS

1. CONFERENCE WEEK (5-9 September 2005)

Cost: 300 euros

Monday, 5 September: SEA TRIP

Departing from Yasmine Hammamet marina on board a pirate ship for a trip along the coast of Hammamet and its old town; lunch on board: grilled fish, salad, fruit and beverages. Members of this programme will join delegates and observers for the opening ceremony official reception.

Tuesday, 6 September: KAIROUAN/SOUSSE/MONASTIR

Excursion to Kairouan to visit the Great Mosque of Okba Ibn Nafaa, the Barber's Mausoleum and the Aghlabides pool. Visit to a carpet-making centre. Visit to Sousse medina. After lunch, visit to the Bourguiba Mausoleum in Monastir. We will return to the Conference Center for the Bronze Wolf Ceremony. Members of this programme will join delegates and observers for the special cultural Berbère evening programme and dinner.

Wednesday 7 September: EL JEM ROMAN COLISEUM

This historic and grandiose setting will welcome the Conference participants for an exceptional day. The coliseum is the third-largest amphitheatre of the Old World. While delegates and observers are working in groups, members of this programme will have an afternoon seeing sights in the area. Refreshments and drinks will be served. In the evening we all come together for dinner and an impressive show in the coliseum.

Thursday 8 September: TUNIS/CARTHAGE/BARDO/SIDI BOU SAID

Trip to Tunis medina and its old town, its typical souks and the rare mosaics in the Bardo museum. After lunch, the excursion continues to the picturesque town of Sidi Bou Said to admire the architecture of its houses before moving on to the Roman site of Carthage. We will return to the hotels for the free evening.

Friday 9 September: HAMMAMET/NABEUL MARKET

Visit to Hammamet medina and the Spanish fortress, then on to Nabeul via the scenic route to visit a pottery studio, followed by an unaccompanied stroll through Nabeul market. (Lunch not included.) Members of this programme will join delegates and observers for the closing ceremony dinner banquet.

Additional Information

1. A tourist guide will accompany all the excursions, which will be by air-conditioned bus or mini-bus (depending on the number of participants).
2. Costs include lunch and admission fees, unless stated otherwise.
3. Beverages are not included, except for the folklore evening and the sea trip.
4. Permission to take photographs is charged at certain sites. (1 TND).
5. Appropriate dress required to visit the Great Mosque in Kairouan.
6. Half-price for children under 12.
7. The 300 euro registration fee covers all excursions during the week of 5-9 September as well as access to the opening ceremony and official reception, dinner at the Berbère evening, dinner at the Coliseum, and the closing ceremony and banquet.

Access to dinners and receptions will be limited to registered Delegates, Observers, and members of the Accompanying Persons' Programme.

2. AFTER THE CONFERENCE (10-15 September): The South (2 days)

Saturday, 10 and Sunday, 11 September

Cost: 100 euros/per person

Day 1: visit of the town of Sfax, and then on to Gabès and its spice market, Matmata and its cave dwellings, Douz and its sand dunes. Overnight accommodation in Kebili. (Single-room supplement, payable at the hotel.)

Day 2: drive across Chott El Jérid by four-wheel-drive vehicle to visit the mountain oases of Chébika et Mides. Brief stops in Gafsa and Kairouan.
