World Scout Bureau Services

I am pleased to inform you that, with a view to strengthening the support offered by the World Scout Bureau headquarters in Geneva to National Scout Organizations, a number of organizational and staff changes have been made within the Bureau.

Dominique Bénard, who was until recently European Regional Director, has been appointed *director, Youth Programme*. The *deputy director of Youth Programme* is **Jacqueline Collier**, also previously with the European Region.

Jim Sharp, formerly director of Youth Programme, has been appointed as *director, Relationships*, and will handle the World Organization's institutional relationships with external bodies such as the UN and other governmental and non-governmental organizations, as well as strengthen the quality of the World Bureau's support to the World Scout Committee.

Jean Cassaigneau, formerly director of Relationships and Special Events, has been appointed *director, World Events*. His service, thanks primarily to funding from the host organizations of forthcoming world events, has been significantly strengthened to respond to the growing needs in that sector. **Jean-Luc Bertrand**, formerly assistant director of Youth Programme, has been appointed *assistant director, World Events*, for Programme and Partnership Management. **Lutz Kübner** has been appointed, as of 1 October 2000, *assistant director, World Events*, for Human Resources, Logistics and Risk Management. **Shana McElroy** will continue, until 31 December 2000, as *Junior Officer* in the World Events unit, in order to promote youth participation in Scout and non-Scout international events.

We hope that the above changes will strengthen the World Scout Bureau's capacity to respond to the needs of our Movement.
