REBUILDING CAPACITY SCOUT AID - NEPAL EARTHQUAKE

Short Term Assistance (Rescue and Relief)

Beneficiaries:

Scouts and their communities in Nepal

Activities:

- Relief actions directed at Scouts and their families
- Relief actions that involve Scouts, although may be coordinated by other agencies
- Rebuilding Projects including helping children in rescue and relief centers to recover from the trauma of the earthquake through engaging them in Scout activities

Medium to Long Term Assistance (Recovery and Rehabilitation)

Beneficiaries:

Mostly the Scouting community in Nepal

Activities:

- Rebuilding structures and infrastructure, e.g. Scouting facilities that serve as headquarters, training centres and educational facilities
- Opening new Scout Groups
- Skills development and livelihoods training for Scouts affected by the earthquake

Long Term to Permanent (Development Education)

Beneficiaries:

Scouts in Nepal, in particular with impact on local, national and global communities

Activities:

- Disaster Risk Reduction Management Training
- Life Skill education to young people affected by the disaster
- Environment Education
