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H.E. Dr. Taysser Al Ne'amy, Jordanian Minister of Education held a meeting with Dr. Atif Abdelmageed, Arab Scout Regional Director, to discuss the preparations for the 10th Arab Scout Gathering for Executives of Health Awareness in the Arab Scout Organizations. During the said meeting, Dr. Al Ne'amy confirmed that the Ministry is working hard for the protection of youth health according to the personal instructions of H.H. King of Jordan.
